



## Indiana Health Information Exchange

The Indiana Health Information Exchange is the nation's largest health information exchange organization. IHIE connects disparate hospitals and physician offices, enabling medical information to follow patients regardless of treatment location. The IHIE network includes over 80 hospitals and 18,000 physicians providing care to over ten million patients. [www.ihie.org](http://www.ihie.org)

IHIE was formed by the Regenstrief Institute, private hospitals, local and state health departments, BioCrossroads and other prominent organizations in Indiana. An IHIE-led collaboration (Central Indiana Beacon Community) is one of 17 national cooperatives to help advance healthcare quality and efficiency. This collaboration will help communities in Indiana identify opportunities to measurably improve patient care through its chronic disease, preventive care service. This service also doubles as a pay-for-value program, aligning physician reimbursement from payers to improvements in patient outcomes.
